To the FEMA SECC and Government Relations Committee, and the FMA SAC and Government and International Relations Committee:

Today, the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) published the latest round of results from their Proposition 65 prioritization procedure.

As you may recall, trans-anethole and 3,4-dihydrocoumarin were under consideration for further prioritization, and perhaps for eventual listing as carcinogens under Prop 65. Both substances were assigned a "Category II" priority level meaning that OEHHA has concluded that neither poses a "high carcinogenicity concern." This means that it is unlikely that OEHHA will take any action to list these substances in the foreseeable future.
